



Level 4 Diploma in Arboriculture September 2021 Intake

Pre-requisites: Ideally, candidates will have a Level 2 Certificate in Arboriculture or an equivalent qualification along with relevant experience.

This course runs for 1 year within a traditional academic term timetable in the form of 15 full day sessions plus additional online portal guidance, or 15 online sessions featuring recorded video lectures to allow increased schedule flexibility.

Assessment type: Portfolio of evidence, to be moderated a year after the course starts.
