



Level 6 Diploma in Arboriculture

October 2021 Intake

Pre-requisites: Ideally, candidates will have a level 4 Diploma in Arboriculture or an equivalent qualification along with relevant experience.

This course runs for 2 years within a traditional academic term timetable in the form of up to 25 full day sessions plus additional online portal guidance, or up to 25 online sessions featuring recorded video lectures to allow increased schedule flexibility.

Assessment type: Portfolio of evidence, to be moderated two years after the course starts.
Awarding body: ABC Awards.
